| <u>HB998</u>           | Set date = Extension from 7 to 10 days to certify results of election *HB 998 sponsor but HB 1238 language adopted  | Signed by Governor Takes effect July 1,2024 |
| <u>SB605</u>           | Expands definition of "disability". Currently as defined limits to permanent or temporary physical disability.  | Signed by Governor Takes effect July 1,2024 |
| <u>HB 1408</u>         | Dept of Elections develops guidelines for local gov't   | <u>VETO</u>                                 |
| <u>SB428</u>           | Ranked Choice vote - Sb270 (POTUS), SB428 (Local), HB841 (local)  | 270 & 841 - Pushed to 2025<br>SB428 - Veto  |
| <u>HB 623</u>          | "The governing body of any county or city may establishthe dates and hours of operations of such satellite offices"   | VETO  |
| <u>SB364</u>           | Increased protections for election officers & Class 5 felony for preventing election officer from admin election. Substitute includes Class 6 felony potential for serious threats. | Returned to Sen<br>w/Recommendations        |
| <u>HB904</u>           | Voter registration records/removal of registered voter. To be taken up next week.   | Returned to House w/Recommendations         |
