Bill No	Description	Status
<u>HB998</u>	Set date = Extension from 7 to 10 days to certify results of election *HB 998 sponsor but HB 1238 language adopted	<u>Signed by Governor</u> <u>Takes effect July 1,2024</u>
<u>SB605</u>	Expands definition of "disability". Currently as defined limits to permanent or temporary physical disability.	<u>Signed by Governor</u> <u>Takes effect July 1,2024</u>
<u>HB 1408</u>	Dept of Elections develops guidelines for local gov't	<u>VETO</u>
<u>SB428</u>	Ranked Choice vote - Sb270 (POTUS), SB428 (Local), HB841 (local)	<u>270 & 841 - Pushed to 2025</u> <u>SB428 - Veto</u>
<u>HB 623</u>	"The governing body of any county or city may establish...the dates and hours of operations of such satellite offices..."	<u>VETO</u>
<u>SB364</u>	Increased protections for election officers & Class 5 felony for preventing election officer from admin election. Substitute includes Class 6 felony potential for serious threats.	<u>Returned to Sen</u> <u>w/Recommendations</u>
<u>HB904</u>	Voter registration records/removal of registered voter. To be taken up next week.	<u>Returned to House</u> <u>w/Recommendations</u>
General Assembly DATES	April 17 = Reconvened session to consider Governor's amendments and vetoes
